## Serving the Community

West Virginia Health Right started with a need-base of only 60 people, and only 20 years later, has now grown to serving nearly 22,000 patients. As the number of people uninsured and under-insured grows, Health Right is prepared and ready to help. With a small paid staff, volunteers are the main foundation. There are more than 500 medical and nonmedical volunteers that give their time and efforts to see improvement in the health of West Virginia.



Health Right serves qualified adults 18-64 who do not have health insurance or cannot afford to pay for health care. They operate the largest and only full time, free adult dental clinic, as well as in 2008. expanding the pharmacy with WVRx to bring the first statewide charitable central fill mail order pharmacy. They work alongside other free clinics in West Virginia to help the wellbeing of their state

Currently, West Virginia Health Right is funded through donations and the AstraZereca "Pathways to Cardio- AstraZenec HealthCare Foundation vascular Health" HealthCare Foundation, which allowed for the implementation of "Pathways to Cardiovascular Health", an interactive program designed to education people about their heart. 300 people stopped using tobacco products after enrolling in PufferSnuffer, a class oftered through Pathways.
